

DANIELS GATE RECREATION ASSOCIATION, INC.
RECREATION CENTER/POOL RULES AND REGULATIONS

The pool season opens at the start of Memorial Day weekend in May and closes at the end of Labor Day weekend in September of each year. The pool may be kept open longer in September at the discretion of the Board of Directors.

Pool gates are to be locked at all times so that only those who have been issued access cards may enter. Climbing the pool fence to gain entry is EXTREMELY HAZARDOUS and is a violation of the rules. Violators, who violate the rules, may be subject to fines and prosecution.

Quiet lap swim only period
6:00a.m.-9:00a.m., 8:00pm-8:30pm

Please take the time to familiarize yourself and your family with the pool rules and regulations.

- Swim at your own risk and for liability purposes, there is no lifeguard on duty.
- For safety reasons children less than 16 years of age must be accompanied and supervised by an adult or responsible care provider over the age of 18, who are expected to take full responsibility for the children.
- Bicycles, tricycles, skateboards, roller-skates, rollerblades, small balls and Frisbees are not allowed in the pool area. Inflatable beach balls and inflatable toys are allowed only if they do not interfere with other swimmers. Rubber and plastic floats designed to function as swimming and safety aids are allowed.
- Persons with infectious diseases, open sores, bandaged wounds or recent vaccinations are not permitted in the pool or pool area.
- Excessive drinking of alcoholic beverages in the pool area is prohibited. **ABSOLUTELY NO GLASS CONTAINERS ALLOWED!!!!**
- Running, punching, spitting, undue splashing, loud radios, excessive noises, profane language and/or other obnoxious behavior is prohibited. Board members, supervisory personnel and staff retained by the Association have authority to evict anyone from the pool for infractions of these rules.
- Anyone who causes damage to the pool and/or its accessories shall be held financially responsible and may lose recreational privileges.
- Non toilet trained babies and children must wear swim diapers.
- **NO SMOKING** inside the pool area.
- Proper swim attire is required. Cut-offs are not allowed. Loose fitting jewelry (i.e., necklaces, bracelets, hoop or dangle earrings) are not allowed.
- Pick up your trash.

- Report all accidents or injuries occurring on association property immediately to the attendant on duty or the Associations' managing agent.
- NO cooking or GLASSWARE of any kind is allowed. Snack type foods and beverages in unbreakable containers are allowed 8 feet outside the perimeter of the pool.
- Pets are prohibited in the pool enclosure at all times, except service animals. Pets shall not be chained or tied to the pool fence or trees anywhere near the pool.
- Vandalism: Please be aware that the pool and pool area are under video surveillance. If a person is observed or caught vandalizing the pool or facilities on video, they will be reported to law enforcement and the homeowner of record will not be allowed to use the pool until all damage and repair is paid in full.

Rules and regulations are for the protection and benefit of all members. Parents are instructed to caution their children to observe the rules and obey the instructions of the pool attendant and other supervisory personnel. Violators may be asked to leave the pool area. Parents will be notified of continual violations committed by their children.

The pool attendant and/or other authorized supervisory personnel are authorized to initiate temporary policies or rules at any time such action is necessary. Any policies or rules will be reported to the Board of Directors.

Violators may be asked to leave the pool area for infractions of these rules at the discretion of the management or other supervisory personnel. Additionally, violators may lose their recreational privileges for a period of time commensurate with the offense.

GUEST POLICY

Only Daniels Gate residents and their guests may use the pool facilities. Residents must accompany guests. Residents are responsible for their guests and any children. Guests are to observe the rules and obey the instructions of the recreation center, the onsite attendant and other supervisory personnel. Residents under age 18 may invite only 2 guests at a time.

CLUBHOUSE RENTAL FOR PRIVATE PARTIES

The clubhouse may be rented for use by Daniels Gate residents. If you rent the clubhouse for an event, you may have access for use of the pool with execution of a use agreement and payment of the applicable fee and deposit. However, you do not have exclusive use of the pool; the pool is always open to Daniels Gate Residents. If you wish to use the pool in conjunction with the clubhouse rental, you may be required to pay for a special pool attendant at the rate of \$15.00 per hour. If your rental time surpasses the closing time of the pool, and you have a pool attendant, they will be required to stay for the complete time of your reservation.

Members wishing to rent the clubhouse must complete and submit the Use Agreement available on the Clubhouse Reservations tab of the Daniels Gate Recreation Association website (www.danielsgaterec.com) to the managing agent (below), along with the appropriate checks for nonrefundable use fees and refundable security deposit. Any damage to the clubhouse or pool property by you or your guests during the clubhouse rental may cause you to forfeit all or a part of your security deposit.
