The Painting/Repainting section of the Design Guidelines are hereby modified to add the following requirements.

Upon receipt of a color change paint request by the Architectural Review Committee(ARC), the ARC shall contact the owner(s) and request that the owner(s), at their own expense paint 'swatches' of each paint color being requested in an appropriate area of their home (ie: base color/siding, trim, and trim #2 if requested). The owner shall advise the ARC of the completion of the color 'swatching'. The ARC shall along with adjoining neighbors view the paint colors in order to determine compliance with the Design Guidelines requirement of blending with the natural site conditions and minimize light reflective qualities. (refer to November 29, 2001 Design Guidelines, page 9) The ARC shall either accept or reject the request after inspection of the paint samples.
