TRAFFIC ADVISORY

Union Pacific RR Bridge

CASTLE ROCK – Interstate 25 will be closed to traffic at night through Castle Rock for demolition of the old Union Pacific Railroad Bridge, located just north of Wolfensberger Road. It will require a five-night closure, beginning *next* weekend. The Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT) plans to close the highway as follows:

Sunday through Thursday, October 16 – 20, Northbound & Southbound I-25

- One lane closed – 8 p.m.
- **All lanes of northbound and southbound I-25 CLOSED at 9p.m. between Meadows Parkway and Wolfensberger Road.** *Detour in place – see below*
- All lanes open to traffic by 5:30 a.m. each morning

DETOUR: Northbound I-25 traffic will exit at Wolfensberger Road, go west to Prairie Hawk Drive, north on Prairie Hawk to Meadows Parkway, east on Meadows to I-25. Southbound I-25 traffic will reverse this detour route. The State Patrol will be assisting with traffic control. Oversized and wide loads will **NOT** be allowed to travel the detour route while I-25 is closed.

All closures are weather-permitting.
